

Who we are

While the primary mandate of the Home is to provide holidays for disadvantaged children; during the school terms we open our amazing facility to groups from schools, churches, service groups and even small businesses looking for a comfortable, fully catered and affordable destination.

- We are permitted, in terms of our PBO licence, to raise funds to assist in our sustainability by hosting paying groups.
- To capitalize on this opportunity, we market ourselves to schools throughout KwaZulu-Natal.
- Many schools return on an annual basis with new groups of children. Some of these schools are Creighton Primary, Ixopo Primary, and Briardene Primary to name a few.

Tariffs

Our tariffs for children 13 years and younger are R230 excl. VAT per child per day, and R280 excl. VAT per child per day for 14 years and older. Adults accompanying children are charged R280 excl. VAT per day.

We also welcome day visits from schools for which we charge a flat rate of R30 excl. VAT per person. This rate excludes any catering, but does include the use of all outdoor facilities. For the day program with our educators, an additional charge of R30 per child is applicable. Lunch can be provided at R60 per person excl. VAT but requires prior arrangement with the management. We offer a package deal of R100 per child (excl. VAT) including entrance fees, meals and educators.




What we offer

We are located just more than an hour's drive south of Durban and our Home is situated right on the beach in large, well-equipped, fully fenced grounds surrounded by beautiful indigenous coastal bush. Whales and dolphins are often spotted playing just beyond the breakers – a thrill our visitors never tire of.

Accommodation is in dormitories – divided into two wings for boys and girls. In total we can accommodate 120 children. Separate en-suite rooms can accommodate teachers. We provide three meals a day and send schools menus to select from ahead of a visit. All bedding, linen and housekeeping services are provided. There is also ample secure parking on site for cars and buses.
